Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Departure from the UK

Depart from the United Kingdom: and fly to Keflavik airport, Iceland.
Reykjavik: Evening Supper and a review of tomorrow's schedule of events.
Reykjavik: Overnight Stay

Day 2 Geothermal Energy & Power

Hveragerdi: Walking exploration of this area, as we observe plant life, fruit and flowers that are grown in large greenhouses, heated by geothermal energy.
Geysir: The original and most famous hot spring geyser.
Stokkir: See Stokkir spout water every few minutes.
Nesjavellir: Geothermal power station visit in Reykjavik, and then follow the hot water pipeline over the lava fields back to the capital.
Perlan: Café and cultural centre situated atop 5 hot water tanks on Oskjuhlid Hill, with great views over the city.
Reykjavik: Overnight stay and supper.

Day 3 Coast & Waterfalls

Dyrhólaey: Rock formations and unusual coastal arches and stacks.
Vik: A remarkable feature is the beautiful black beach with black basalt columns sculpted by the sea.
Skogar Waterfall: A spectacular waterfall with cliffs surrounding this location.
Seljalandsfoss Waterfall: drops 60 meters over the cliffs of the former coastline. It is possible to go behind the waterfall.
Hvolsvollur area: Evening supper and overnight stay, and today's discussion and tomorrow's schedule of events.

Day 4 Rivers & Glaciers

Eyjavallajökull: Icecap viewing and observation.
Solheimajökull glacier: Exploration and viewing of glacier and snout.
Thorsmork: A rugged yet very beautiful area with spectacular glacial scenery. Explore and hike these wooded hills, which offer excellent views of Myrdalsjokul Glacier and icecap, and the Markafjot glacial rivers.
Hvolsvollur area: Overnight stay and evening meal.

Day 5 Volcanoes & Tectonic Plates - Return to the UK

Eldborg Volcano: We will stop at a cone shaped volcano where we can climb to the top of the crater to take a look down into the volcano.
The Blue Lagoon: World famous bright blue mineral-rich swimming pool, with geothermally heated water in the middle of a large lava field.
Reykjanes peninsula: Almost completely covered with old lava flows. You will see lava cones and craters of different size and shapes as well the tectonic plates.
Keflavik: Transfer to the airport for our return flight home to the UK.

This daily itinerary is currently being reviewed subsequent to the volcanic activity in April 2010 and will be adjusted where necessary.

Optional Itinerary Activities include:

Swimming Pools, Horse Riding, River Rafting, Whale Watching, Jokularlon Glacial Lagoon, Coastal Walks, Ten Pin Bowling and Ice Skating.

Westman Islands Extension

OPTION FOR AN ADDITIONAL OR ALTERNATIVE DAY



Heimaey, the largest of the Westman Islands and the only inhabited one, is home to some 5,000 people and millions of birds, especially sea birds. On Heimaey, sights to see include the volcanic crater formed during the 1973 eruption. We hear the story of the eruption and the consequences that this natural catastrophe had on the community and the island's environment.

Namibia



Environmental Education Study

Explore deserts and canyons and spend three days for hands-on, experiential, outdoor learning in a desert environment at Nadeet Centre; students participate in many activities such as solar cooking, recycling paper and learning about the plants and animals first-hand.



Day 1 Departure from London
Fly from London to Windhoek, Namibia.

Day 2 Windhoek
Arrive and transfer to your hotel. Afternoon visit to a museum or local market.

Day 3 Windhoek - Namib Desert
We travel into the oldest desert on earth. We will explore unique petrified dunes on a nature drive and travel to the highest dunes on earth at Sossusvlei. We will also visit Sesriem Canyon, gorged out by the Tsauchab River.

Days 4-6 The Namib Desert Environmental Education Trust
We have three days for hands-on, experiential, outdoor learning about the plants and animals in the desert environment.

Days 7-8 Fish River Canyon
We visit Fish River Canyon, the second largest canyon on earth. We observe the fragile desert ecosystem and the plant life that thrives there.

Day 9 Quiver Tree Forest - Kalahari
This morning we drive to the spectacular Quiver Tree Forest. The quiver tree is indigenous to the hot and dry southern part of Namibia. We continue into the Kalahari Desert.

Day 10 Kalahari - Rehoboth - Windhoek
Look out for a variety of antelope, smaller mammals, insects and reptiles that inhabit this desert as you explore this specialised ecosystem. From here we drive to Windhoek.

Day 11 Windhoek, Fly to the UK
Today is free for last-minute shopping or further sightseeing. Leave for the airport late in the afternoon.

Day 12 Arrive UK
Arrive back in London this morning.

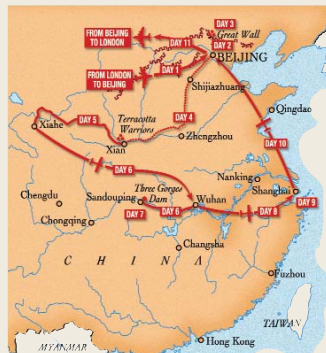

China



China & the Three Gorges Dam

As well as seeing the main sights in Beijing, Xian and Shanghai, this tour has a geographical emphasis visiting the incredible Three Gorges Dam Project, also studying residential urban projects, rural farms and a factory.



Day 1-2 Fly to Beijing
We fly overnight from the UK to Beijing. We will visit the brand new Beijing Olympic Stadium.

Day 3 Beijing
Our morning commences in Tian'an Men Square. We also visit the Forbidden City and the Temple of Heaven.

Day 4 Great Wall & Ming Tombs
This morning we visit the Great Wall of China, one of the world's most awesome sights. In the afternoon we visit the Ming Tombs, where Chinese emperors are buried.

Day 5 Factory Visit - Hutong Tour - Train to Xian
This morning we visit a traditional manufacturing plant and then we will visit a hutong, a unique form of traditional community. Later, we take the overnight express train to Xian.

Days 6-7 Xian - Terra Cotta Warriors - Wuhan
A city tour of Xian will be followed by a visit to the Terra Cotta Army Museum site. On day 7 we fly to Wuhan and drive to the Yangtze River Three Gorges Project where we can examine the environmental impact and the economic benefits.

Day 8 Three Gorges Dam
In the morning we will be escorted by a local expert to visit the Three Gorges Project. After lunch we drive back to Wuhan and visit a local private farm.

Days 9-10 Fly to Shanghai
We fly to Shanghai and take a Huangpu River Cruise and then visit the Jade Buddha Temple. On our second day included are the Shanghai Museum and the Shanghai Stock Exchange. In the evening we will ascend the Jin Mao Tower, the tallest building in China where we will enjoy magnificent views.

Day 11 Departure Shanghai - Arrive UK
Transfer to the airport for the return flight home. You land back in the UK later the same day.

Day 1 London - Morocco
Fly from London to Marrakech. Visit Djemaa el Fna to watch the amazing acrobats, snake charmers and performers.

Day 2 Marrakech - Ouarzazate
This morning we have a guided tour of Marrakech. After lunch we depart for Ouarzazate, travelling through the foothills of the Atlas foothills, and pay a visit to the truly amazing World Heritage Site at Ait Benhaddou.

Day 3 Ouarzazate - Todra Gorge
We head through the beautiful Valley du Dades and also visit the spectacular Todra Gorge. An afternoon hike will reveal the diverse landscapes and reveal the glory of the canyon.

Days 4 & 5 The Sahara Desert
We continue to Merzouga. Here in the shadow of the Dunes of Erg Chebbi we will spend the next two days in a desert Auberge and desert Bivouac experiencing the fabulous Sahara Desert. We will travel into the desert on camels, over sand dunes and rocky escarpments. During the day, we will have time to explore the surrounding area by foot, climbing the dunes and taking in all the Sahara has to offer. At night we can enjoy traditional Berber song and dance before we lie under the stars and look at the constellations.

Day 6 Merzouga - Ouarzazate
Return to Ouarzazate and this evening we will have a special Moroccan Dinner where local musicians will entertain us.

Day 7 Ouarzazate - Tiffoutoute - Marrakech
This morning it's just a short drive to the Berber Village of Tiffoutoute. Here there is an opportunity to experience and get a real feel for rural life in Morocco. Then it's off again across the High Atlas Mountains to return to Marrakech.

Day 8 Departure Back To London
Your trip to Morocco ends with a short drive to Marrakech Airport for the return flight home.

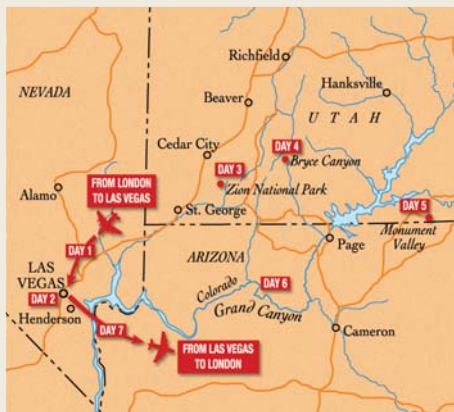

Discovering National Parks

Visit diverse and dramatic landscapes in Zion and Bryce National Parks, Monument Valley and the Grand Canyon, not to mention Las Vegas, as you journey through the states of Nevada, Utah and Arizona.



Day 1 London To Las Vegas
Fly to Las Vegas and transfer to your hotel.

Days 2/3 Las Vegas - Zion National Park
We will have this morning to enjoy a tour of the glitz and glitter of Las Vegas. We then travel into Utah's canyon country. We will begin with Zion National Park with its towering sandstone cliffs. We will take a hike along the Virgin River, 1000 feet above the river canyon.

Day 4 Bryce Canyon
Continuing to Bryce Canyon we enter this hidden park, which is a marvel of red and orange rock 'hoodoo' spires that stand sentinel over eons of erosion. The National Park is a scientist's laboratory with unique rock formations. We will walk to Yovimpa Point to study the sequence of rock layers called the Grand Staircase and take a hike along the rim.

Day 5 Monument Valley
Monument Valley is a Navajo Nation tribal park, which preserves the Navajo way of life and has some of the most striking and recognisable landscapes in the SouthWest. The mesas and buttes stand straight up from the red desert floor have been the backdrop for many Hollywood Western movies. We take a jeep trek with a Native American guide.

Day 6 Grand Canyon
We continue on to the high desert of northern Arizona to visit one of the world's greatest natural wonders, the Grand Canyon. Desert View Drive follows the canyon rim for 26 miles and offers spectacular views of the canyon. We stop at the excellent Visitor Centre for full geological background information and for some more breathtaking viewpoints, and then we will have a chance either this afternoon or tomorrow morning to go for a short hike into the Canyon rim.

Days 7/8 Depart Las Vegas - Arrive London
We continue back to Las Vegas airport for the flight home. Your flight arrives back in the UK early the next day.

Italy



Exploring Campania

Campania's spectacular natural beauty and unparalleled wealth of archaeological excavations are explored on this contrasting and special tour.



Day 1 Fly London To Naples
Today we will fly to Naples and transfer to our hotel in Sorrento.

Day 2 Solfatara-Herculaneum-Sorrento
This morning we will tour the ancient sights at Pozzuoli, such as the Amphitheatre and the Temple of Serapis. As we leave town, we will stop at the Solfatara Crater that still emits the streams of steam. We also visit Herculaneum, buried in mud in the same cataclysm that destroyed Pompeii.

Day 3 The Amalfi Drive & Paestum
The Amalfi Drive is Italy's most spectacular coastline. On route we will make a stop at the picturesque town of Amalfi before continuing to Paestum, founded by the Greeks around 600 BC. The Temple of Neptune is among the best preserved temples in Italy or Greece.

Day 4 Vesuvius & Pompeii
This morning we make a visit to the top of Mt. Vesuvius itself before we head south to the magnificent Roman ruins at Pompeii, which give a fascinating glimpse into Roman life. In 79 AD, the fury of nearby Mt. Vesuvius was unleashed upon this prosperous city, killing its 2,000 inhabitants and burying it under pumice and ash. Today, the excavations reveal the ruins of the city's amphitheatres, forum, baths, streets and splendid houses, some with their frescoes still visible.

Day 5 Day Trip To Capri
Today we make an early start to the port of Sorrento for an excursion to the beautiful Island of Capri. We take a boat trip to the Blue Grotto before taking the funicular up the steep cliff side to the town of Capri and the famous Piazza Umberto.

Day 6 Sorrento - Naples - London
Today we will return to Naples Airport. Time permitting, we will visit the National Archaeological Museum, with its Roman and Greek sculpture. Your tour guide accompanies you to the airport for the return flight home.

Our tour introduces the full diversity and uniqueness of this fascinating country driving through mountains, desert and coastal regions. The special geographical study visits will be informative and interesting.



Day 1 Arrive Tunisia Carthage Airport
This morning you will fly to Tunisia. You will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 Tunis, The Souks & The Medina
There will be a conducted tour of Tunis to include the Medina, the 12th Century old town. After lunch we depart to Ichkeul National Park. Lake Ichkeul is the last of a chain of shallow freshwater lakes which once extended all along the northern African seaboard. We will continue to Utica the earliest Phoenician trading post. We then drive to Hammamet.

Day 3 Hammamet - Nabeul- Zaghuan - Tozeur
After breakfast we depart to Nabeul, the pottery centre of Tunisia. We continue to Zaghuan where we will visit a farm and discover the tools of traditional farmers. Our next destination is Gafsa with a stop at the famous twin Roman pools. We then continue to Tozeur and visit the old town, little changed since the 14th century. In the evening we take a Caleche Ride through the palm and olive groves of Tozeur.

Day 4 Tozeur - Chott El Jerid - Douz
We will take an exciting 4x4 Jeep Excursion to the Mountain Oases. Then we drive south into Tunisia's spectacular mountain scenery with visits to the Mountain Oasis of Tamerza. Then it's on to explore the shimmering Chott El Jerid salt lake. We continue to Douz the Oasis town. A camel trek over the sand dunes of the Sahara Desert with overnight Bivouac is an exciting experience.

Day 5 Douz - Matmata - El Djem - Hammamet
Departure to Matmata of Star Wars notoriety and the centre of an extensive number of traditional troglodyte pit homes. This afternoon will be spent at El Djem, which represents the glory of the Roman Empire. We continue on to Hammamet.

Day 6 Hammamet - Tunis
We will drive to Tunis Airport for the flight home, which lands later the same day.

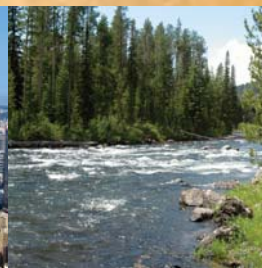
