# CHINA

## Ancient & Modern

China is a unique destination in the world of travel. As well as being the world's most populous country and oldest continuous civilisation, it contains a wealth of attractions. Its ancient sculptures, murals, burial sites and temples are renowned throughout the world and many ancient colourful traditions and historic customs still function today.

### Suggested Itinerary

#### Day 1 Departure

Enjoy full meal service on your scheduled wide-bodied flight to Beijing.

#### Day 2 Arrive Beijing

Our English-speaking guide will meet us at the airport and accompany us on our transfer by private coach to our hotel in central Beijing. Time permitting, we will visit the Olympic sites including the brand new Beijing Stadium where the opening ceremony and many events took place.

#### Day 3 Beijing

Our morning commences in Tian'an Men Square and continues with a visit to the Forbidden City, a massive complex of red-walled buildings and pavilions topped by a sea of glazed vermilion tile where emperors lived. We conclude with a visit to the Temple of Heaven, an enormous park and altar directly to the south of the Forbidden City. Each winter solstice, the Ming and Qing emperors would lead a procession here to perform rites and make sacrifices designed to promote the next year's crops. Tonight we will attend either a Martial Arts demonstration show or choose to watch an Acrobat Show.

#### Day 4 The Great Wall Of China & Ming Tombs

This morning we visit the Great Wall of China, one of the world's most awesome and impressive sights. In the afternoon we visit the Ming Tombs where 13 of the 16 emperors who ruled China during the Ming dynasty (1368-1644) are buried. This evening we will enjoy a Peking Duck Dinner.

#### Day 5 Summer Palace - Hutong Tour - Overnight Train to Xian

This morning we begin with a visit to the Summer Palace, the grandest imperial playground in China. In the afternoon we will take a Beijing Hutong Tour. A hutong is a unique form of community with a small street or a lane between two courtyards. We will enjoy a fascinating tour by Rickshaw, which offer a magnificent glance into residential Chinese life. Later, we take the brand new overnight express train to Xian.

#### Day 6 Arrive Xian - Terra Cotta Warriors

We arrive in Xian where we have breakfast before embarking on a tour around the Xian City Walls. The magnificent Xian City Wall was constructed in the early Ming Dynasty, and is one of the best-preserved ancient walls around a city anywhere in the world. This afternoon we will visit the Terra Cotta Army Museum. Excavations in 1974 revealed thousands of life-sized warriors and their horses, an entire army designed to follow its emperor into eternity. This evening our guide will take us to a bustling local market for shopping.



#### Day 7 Xian - Flight To Guilin

This morning we take a flight to the picturesque city of Guilin, famous for its elegant peaks, crystal-clear waters, enchanting rocks and fantastic caves. This afternoon we will visit the Reed-Flute Cave with its dazzling stalactite and stalagmite formations.

#### Day 8 Li River Cruise

Today we will take a Li River Cruise (4 hours), a relaxing way to view the beauty of Guilin's lush green valleys, bamboo groves and hundreds of fascinating rock formations. We will also be introduced to the ancient method of fishing, before concluding the cruise in Yangshuo, where we will visit the local market, one of the most colorful in the region.

#### Day 9 Flight To Shanghai

This morning we fly to Shanghai, China's largest and most dynamic city. Our sightseeing commences with a Huangpu River Cruise. As we sail down the river we will enjoy the views of the full sweep of The Bund and the 21st century cityscape of Pudong. Our day continues with a stroll along Nanjing Road, China's premier shopping street. This evening we will visit the Jin Mao Tower, at 1,379 ft the tallest building in China where we can enjoy magnificent views from the public observation deck on the 88th floor, known as The Skywalk.

#### Day 10 Shanghai

Our day commences with a visit to the Yu Gardens and Bazaar, a pleasant and well-contained classical Chinese garden, a maze of Ming Dynasty pavilions, arched bridges, and goldfish ponds, all encircled by an undulating dragon wall. Next we visit the Shanghai Museum, one of the most important museums in China featuring over 120,000 historic artifacts. Our day concludes with a visit to the Jade Buddha Temple, famous for its jade Buddha statues which are pure white and elegant.

#### Day 11 Departure From Shanghai / Arrive UK

Our enjoyable and rewarding tour will come to an end as our guide accompanies us to the airport for the return flight home. You land back in the UK later the same day.

### Russian History & Politics

This tour provides a fascinating chronological introduction to the History and Politics of Moscow and St Petersburg.



#### Day 1 Departure From London / Arrive Moscow

Fly from London to Moscow. On arrival your guide will take you to your transportation and head straight to the hotel.

#### Day 2 History Of Moscow and Moscow as a Capital

Morning city tour of Red Square and St. Basils Cathedral. In the afternoon we tour the Kremlin and the Armoury museum.

#### Day 3 Moscow Of The 20th Century - Overnight Train

Today we tour the Cosmonauts training centre. We also visit Stalin's Bunker. After dinner, we board the overnight train to St. Petersburg.

#### Day 4 Early St. Petersburg

Today we will visit the famous Nevsky Prospect and also St. Isaac's Cathedral. We will also see the magnificent Peter & Paul fortress which defended the city from Napoleon and which is now the burial place for the last Czar Nicholas II and his family.

#### Day 5 Imperial St. Petersburg

Our day will begin at the Hermitage, one of the largest art museums in the world, containing authentic masterpieces by many of the world's greatest painters and sculptors. We also visit Yussupov Palace where Rasputin was murdered in 1916.

#### Day 6 Revolutionary Russia & Soviet Russia

In the morning we visit the State Museum of the Political History of Russia which reflects decades of the turbulent political life of Russia. We will also visit the cruiser Aurora which fired the shot which signaled the start of the Bolshevik revolution in 1917.

#### Day 7 Flight To London

Your tour will come to an end as your guide accompanies you to the airport for the return flight to London.

#### Additional Day The Siege of Leningrad

Today we will visit the Road of Life Museum, the Nevsky Bridgehead, and the Diorama museum, located where the German fortifications and trenches were successfully stormed, opening the six-day offensive that broke the Siege.

#### Day 1 Depart From London To Mexico City

Flight from London to flight to Mexico City. On arrival your guide will take you to your transport and head straight to the hotel.

#### Day 2 Mexico City And Teotihuacan

Today we will explore the Zocalo, the historic centre of Mexico City. In the afternoon we will enjoy a guided tour of the ancient ruins including the Temple of Quetzalcoatl & Pyramid of the Sun.

#### Day 3 Cuernavaca & Taxco

Today we will explore Cuernavaca, one of the oldest cities in Mexico. We visit the Palacio de Cortes, built by the Spanish on the site of the Aztec pyramids they destroyed.

#### Day 4 Mexico City - Veracruz

Today we travel to Veracruz, Cortes's headquarters after the Spanish Conquest. Visit El Castillo de San Juan de Ulua and the city's renowned aquarium.

#### Day 6-5 Villahermosa - Palenque - Campeche

These days we journey to Villahermosa and Parque Nacional de Palenque. We will visit the Agual Azul waterfalls before continuing to Campeche.

#### Day 7 Campeche - Uxmal - Kabah - Merida

Today we will take a short visit of the city of Campeche, visit the San Miguel Fort, then continue to the Mayan ruin site of Uxmal.

#### Day 8 Merida - Chichen Itza - Cenote Ikkil

We will have a full day exploring the ruins at Chichén Itzá. We return to our hotel in Merida for the evening and dinner at a local restaurant for Yucatecan cuisine.

#### Day 9 Merida City Tour

Today we will take a relaxing walking tour of the city of Mérida, founded in 1542 by the Spanish Conquistadors.

#### Days 10 / 11 Merida - London

Breakfast at the hotel, then transfer to the airport for your flight via Mexico City to London, which arrives the next day.

## USA - East



### American Civil Rights Tour

Discover the people, sites and events behind the African-American Civil Rights Movement (1955-1968) that sought to outlaw discrimination against African Americans and restore suffrage in Southern states by acts of non-violent protest and civil disobedience.



#### Day 1 London To Atlanta

Fly to Atlanta. You will be met on arrival by your guide and transferred to your hotel.

#### Day 2 Atlanta, Georgia

We will have this morning to enjoy a guided tour of the city, including Georgia State Capitol Building and Centennial Olympic Park. In the afternoon we will see sites associated with Martin Luther King and the American Civil Rights Movement, including the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site, the African-American Panoramic Experience (APEX) Museum and the Atlanta History Centre

#### Day 3 Atlanta - Tuskegee - Montgomery

This morning we drive to the Tuskegee Institute National Historic Site. Tuskegee Normal School was influenced by a former slave and a former slave owner to educate newly freed people and their children. We continue to Montgomery where the historic Montgomery Bus Boycott occurred will learn more about this historic action with visits to the Civil Rights Memorial Centre, the Rosa Parks Museum and the King Memorial Dexter Avenue Baptist Church.

#### Day 4 Montgomery - Selma - Birmingham

Today is an early start and we drive towards Selma. We will visit The Marchers Memorial and Interpretive Centre which recounts the history of the area from the early twentieth century struggle for voting rights to the 1965 protests and marches. We also visit the historic Brown Chapel AME church, the location for many of the mass meetings of the Civil Rights Movement. We then travel north to Birmingham, a centre of civil rights action in the past. In Birmingham we will visit the Birmingham Civil Rights Institute.

#### Day 5 Birmingham - Atlanta, Fly To UK

There will be time to visit sites in Birmingham before transferring to Atlanta's International Airport for the flight back to the UK.

#### Day 6 Arrive UK

Your flight arrives back in the UK early this morning.

### American History & Heritage

Follow in the footsteps of young English adventurers and experience American History through the ages from colonisation to Independence, then retrace the suffering of the Civil War soldier through battlefield tours. New York City bridges the past to the present.



**Day 1 Depart London - Arrive Washington - Williamsburg**  
Fly to Washington Dulles Airport. Upon arrival you will be met by your guide and transferred to your hotel in Williamsburg.

**Day 2 Williamsburg - Yorktown - Washington DC**

**Day 3 Washington DC**  
This morning we visit the Washington Monument. We continue down the National Mall to the Lincoln Memorial. After lunch we will visit the Capitol Building where the Senate and House of Representatives have met for more than 200 years.

**Day 4 Gettysburg - New York**  
Today we drive to Gettysburg where we visit the battlefield that ended General Lee's invasion of the North in 1863. We also see the house where President Lincoln stayed prior to his Gettysburg Address. This afternoon we drive to New York and will visit the Top of the Rock for a twilight look over the city that never sleeps.

**Day 5 Manhattan - Central Park - Fifth Avenue**  
Today we have a guided tour of Manhattan including Times Square, Broadway, the Rockefeller Centre, Radio City Hall, the Empire State Building and Grand Central Station. This afternoon we will visit the American Museum of Natural History and walk down Fifth Avenue with its world famous designer shops.

**Day 6 New York - Statue Of Liberty - Ellis Island**  
Today we see the famous New York skyline from the water as we take a boat trip to the Statue of Liberty. We also go to Ellis Island where immigrants were processed before entering America. There will be time for shopping before dinner in the Times Square area.

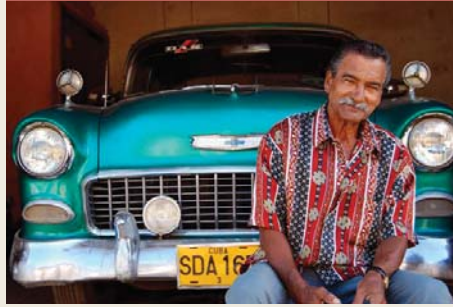
**Days 7/8 Departure - Arrival London**

In the morning we will drive to Guama for a visit to the Crocodile farm. After lunch we continue on to Playa Giron, where the Bay of Pigs invasion occurred in April 1961. We visit the small museum to the attempted CIA-backed invasion of Cuba.

**Day 5 Cienfuegos - Ancon Beach**  
After breakfast we will visit Cienfuegos, a city with plenty of Cuban charm and character. You will be able to visit the Aquarium, with an option to swim with the dolphins.

**Day 6 Trinidad Excursion**  
Today we visit Trinidad, one of the best-preserved colonial towns in Latin America. For a time this city was the capital of sugar production and one of the richest cities in the New World.

**Day 7 Santa Clara - Havana**  
This morning we head for Santa Clara, the site of the last battle of the Cuban revolution in December 1958, the turning point which forced Batista to flee the country.

**Day 8-9 Depart Cuba - Arrive London**  
After lunch we transfer to the airport for your flight which arrives back in London the next day.

**Day 1-2 London to Hanoi**

Over the next two days we will explore sites specific to the northern battle. We visit Red Beach where the Marines first landed in 1965 and will visit the Cham Museum to learn about the ancient Dai Viet Kingdom.

**Day 8 Da Nang - Trakieu - Son My**  
Today we will head south before reaching the village of Son My, the location of the infamous My Lai Massacre. We also visit the site of Cham Ruins that date back to the 5th Century.

**Day 9 Danang - Flight To Ho Chi Minh City**  
Today we fly to Ho Chi Minh City. We visit Reunification Hall, Vinh Nghiem Pagoda and Cholon, Saigon's China Town.

**Day 10 Tay Ninh & Ho Chi Minh City**  
Today we will visit the Cao Dai Temple for the Noon Ceremony. This evening, we enjoy a river cruise for our Farewell dinner.

**Day 11-12 Fly From Ho Chi Minh City to London**  
We transfer to the Airport for our flight to London, arriving the following day.
